



COVID-19 Job Site Procedures

General

1. Limit sharing of any tools
2. Workers are to wear gloves and protective eyewear
3. When having to go into living space workers will wear provided face masks
4. Workers are to maintain social distances guidelines of 6' between anyone else on site, no contact
5. Number of workers performing work on site at any one time will be limited to a maximum of 3
6. Tools, port-a-potty's, any commonly used surfaces such as door handles and knobs will be cleaned 3 times a day; beginning middle and end.

Job Site Set up

1. Every job will have a cleaning kit with hand sanitizer, paper towels, spray bottle with 99.9% Isopropyl rubbing alcohol, facemasks
2. Barrier between living space being used and project job site of either plastic walls, fully sealed against plaster surfaces OR walls remaining and a sealed door
3. When feasible a negative air machine will be set up and ducted to outdoors and away from living spaces.
4. Safety guidelines will be posted at entry to project area

Prior to work day each person working on site will:

7. Report in before work each day that they have been symptom free of any sickness, and fever in particular for the past 24 hours, nor experienced a cough or trouble breathing
8. Has not been in close contact has tested positive for COVID -19, or come into contact with anyone who has tested positive in the past 24 hours
9. Any workers displaying ANY signs of sickness will be sent home

Cleaning Protocol

1. When entering house first time in day; clean hands with sanitizer
2. When Entering for first time in day, Use spray bottle and paper towels, or wipes:
 - a. Clean entry door handle, inside and out
 - b. Clean stair railing
 - c. Project space door handle
3. When leaving for the day, last person to leave, use spray bottle and paper towels, or wipes.
 - a. Clean in opposite direction any door knobs touched and stair railings
 - b. Clean entry door handle
 - c. Remove tack pad dust sheet
